1. Consider Midwest Public Risk (MPR) as the city's insurer for property and casualty placement effective January 1, 2022.

City Administrator Leckey explained the city has been insured through Traveler's for many years as they have always provided the best policy and price. This year at renewal time, our insurance broker obtained a quote through MPR. Because MPR is part of a pool system which includes other cities, schools, and governmental agencies, it gives smaller cities more bargaining power. A comparison sheet was provided to show the differences in premiums and deductibles for the same coverage between Traveler's and MPR. Following discussion of the comparison's, a motion was made.

Motion: Council President McCullagh made a motion to approve MPR for placement of property and casualty insurance for the City of Lake Quivira, Kansas effective January 1, 2022. **Second:** Councilmember Best. **Vote: 3-0. Motion carried.**
